Outstanding Leader Award Nomination Guidelines

It's about the girl! We encourage parents and girls to submit nominations. The Outstanding Leader Award recognizes a troop leader, assistant troop leader, or group leader whose performance in working with girls is outstanding. This awarded recognition is approved at the service unit level. Nomination forms and supporting documentation are to be submitted to Volunteer Services or the service unit team by March 1.

Criteria

1. The nominee is a registered Girl Scout adult.
2. The nominee has demonstrated outstanding leadership, competence in girl-adult partnership, communication, membership development, pluralism, and program delivery.
3. The nominee's work with girls has exceeded expectations for their position.

Nomination

An individual or troop/group familiar with the nominee's performance submits the nomination, along with supporting documentation to Volunteer Services or the service unit. The nomination will describe how the nominee's service has impacted girls through their leadership skills, communication, membership development, pluralism, and program delivery and describe how the nominee's work with girls has exceeded expectation for their position.

Approval

A committee appointed by the service unit team reviews the nomination, approves or denies the nomination, notifies the nominating individual or troop/group, and the service unit is responsible for recognizing the volunteer. Pins can then be purchased at the Showcase. The service unit submits approved name to the Volunteer Services Department by June 1. This award is retiring and not available after June 1, 2012.
